- The day is about giving information and building confidence in newer/inexperienced archers who are starting to look at competing.
- Participant requirement defined as – *“any archer who has never attended a judged or Record Status shoot”*
- There will be one session in the morning and one session in the afternoon, consisting of:
  - For adults; a **Warwick** round; 122cm target face, imperial scoring (9, 7, 5, 3, 1, M), 2 dozen arrows @ 60 yards, 2 dozen arrows @ 50 yards
  - For juniors; a **Warwick 30** round: 122cm target face, imperial scoring (9, 7, 5, 3, 1, M), 2 dozen arrows @ 30 yards, 2 dozen arrows @ 20 yards
- Archers may shoot one or both rounds (AM/PM)
- Chorley Bowmen will aim to place 1 experienced archer on each target, to aid and reassure the Novice archers throughout the sessions
- There will be a lunch break, during which food/drink will be available to purchase from the Chorley Bowmen onsite facilities
- Afternoon spaces - Priority will be given to Novice archers who did not shoot in the morning, any spaces left will be made available to Novice archers who wish to shoot both sessions
- The shoot will be conducted under UK record status/world record status rules, and the LAA “Chronotir” lighting system will be used at this shoot, but with latitude given in regards to the archers being newer and/or inexperienced
- There will be a short presentation (lasting about 30-45 mins) by LAA Judges at the start of each session – this will include: what to expect at competitions, etiquette, inspections, scoring, bouncers, lighting systems etc.
- Experienced club archers and Chorley Bowmen field party will be available to assist in any way required on the day
- Medals will be given for both morning and afternoon shoots – the medal ceremony for the morning shoot will take place before lunch. Any archer shooting both rounds will only be eligible for a medal in the morning shoot.

- LAA medals will be given to all participants - there will be no winners or losers.
- Both club and County records can be claimed at this shoot, as it is a judged shoot.
  
- All archers **MUST** be a member of Archery GB and must be able to present proof of membership upon request

- Target bosses will ideally be “Danage” foam bosses seated on “H frames”, however in exceptional circumstances straw bosses may be utilised
- There will be 4 archers per boss, shooting in two details
- Food and drinks will be available to purchase from the onsite facility (bacon/egg sandwiches AM, burgers/sausages PM)
- Target list/results will be made available on the LAA website
- Archers with a disability should inform the Tournament Organiser at the time of entry, should they wish to stay on the shooting line
- Strictly **No Refunds** within 14 days of the competition
- Categories will consist of:
  - Gent, Lady, Jnr Gent, Jnr Lady
  - Recurve, Compound, Longbow, Barebow

*In line with GDPR: When you enter competitions the following information may be collected and shared with tournament organisers, scoring systems and other competitors for example target lists and results may be published: First Name, Surname, Gender, Bow style, Date of Birth / Age category, Email, Address, Phone number, Club (and ID), County (and ID), Region (and ID), Round (unless defined by age), Disabled (Y/N), Disability info.*
