- Bosses:** Archers will shoot on a mixture of layered foam bosses and traditional three-legged target stands for the shorter rounds. Please consider this if you are using a high-powered bow and arrows that you think may be affected by such bosses and stands.
- Rules** The shoot will be shot to Archery GB rules of shooting - Archery GB dress rules (rule 307) will apply.
- Refreshments:** Hot & cold drinks and snacks will be available during the shoot.
- Photography:** In order to comply with the ArcheryGB Protection of Children and Vulnerable Adults Policy, those who wish to take photographs must register with the Tournament Organiser on arrival.
