Directions to New Brighton Rugby Union Football Club

The Rugby Club is five minutes from the M53.

From Chester/North Wales

Leave the M53 at Junction 1 and at the roundabout take the first exit onto the A554 North Wallasey Approach Road, then take the next exit on the left and join the A551 Leasowe Road. Drive down Leasowe Road, going straight ahead at the roundabout, until you reach traffic lights. Turn left and you are on Reeds Lane and the Rugby Club is about 100 yards on the left, down a small side road.

From Liverpool (Toll route)

Follow signs for the A59, Wallasey (Kingsway) Tunnel (not the Birkenhead (Queensway) Tunnel). Signposted to Wallasey/Chester/North Wales/M53/M56. On leaving the Kingsway Tunnel, continue on the A59. Take the exit toward Birkenhead/New Brighton/Wallasey and merge onto the A5139 which takes you to the roundabout (Junction 1 on the M53). Take the 3rd exit onto the A554 North Wallasey Approach Road, then take the next exit on the left and join the A551 Leasowe Road. Drive down Leasowe Road, going straight ahead at the roundabout, until you reach traffic lights. Turn left and you are on Reeds Lane and the Rugby Club is about 100 yards on the left, down a small side road.

GNAS Rules of Shooting will be observed, including dress code regulations Rule 307.

Photography - In order to comply with GNAS Protection of Children and Vulnerable Adults Policy, anyone wishing to use photographic filming equipment (including mobile phone cameras) may be required to register with the tournament organiser on arrival.

Archers with a disability - Please let the Tournament Organiser know if you have any requirements.

GNAS card - Please bring your GNAS Membership card with you as random checks will be made.

Archers will be required to sign in on arrival.

Drug Testing - Archers competing at Record Status shoots will be liable for drug testing, and competitors approached to give samples must comply. If they refuse, that refusal will be treated as a positive result. [NB, alcohol is a drug]

Juniors must ensure that a Parent or Guardian signs their entry form giving consent to a drug test if required.

Entries from archers, under 18, must be signed by a Parent or Guardian to signify their consent to their child being drug tested if approached.
